






In Person

Same attire as philanthropy

This can be the same outfit you wore from the last round or a slightly different version. Similarly, please keep this round's attire as basic as possible and focus on your values you are representing!

If you choose to wear any article of clothing or accessory that has been advised against, your Rho Gamma may ask you to leave Recruitment and return with the correct attire.



DOs

- Formal attire think sunday brunch with your grandparents
- Dress, romper, pantsuit, jumpsuit, or skirt with nice blouse
- Short heels, sandals (can be open toed), booties, any comfortable shoes

DON'Ts

- Bodycon dresses with lots of cut-outs
 - Heels that are too high to walk in/ stand in for a long time (keep in mind this round is 45 min long)
- Flashy jewelry

Bid

For Bid Day festivities, you will arrive to Trabant in your choice of jeans or pants that meet the dress code from Philanthropy and Sisterhood, as well as a comfortable t-shirt or top you'd like.

After Rho Gamma Reveal and bid distribution, you will be given a t-shirt from your new chapter to be worn for the rest of the evening. Each chapter has a theme to their bid day festivities that is kept very secret until after bid distribution, so it is ok that you do not come dressed to your new chapters theme!

Dos

- Dress to your comfort level! There will be lots of standing/walking so get comfy.
- Wear clothes/ accessories that are meaningful to you!
- Ask your Rho Gamma if your clothes are satisfactory before arriving to rounds!

Donts

- Smart watches, excessive jewelry, clothing accessories
- If you dress against code, you risk being sent home by your Rho Gamma to change.
- Your outfits should not be the main focus of recruitment - it should be getting to know the Panhellenic community and finding which sorority fits you best!

- You must find them before you submit preferences at the end of your Philanthropy event.
- This round you will learn about the chapters' philanthropies.

Sisterhood

- You will visit <u>up to</u>
 6 chapters in person.
- These rounds take place over the course of two days, so your events might be more spaced out.
- The same expectations apply for your Rho Gammas as Philanthropy rounds.
- This round you will learn about each chapters' sisterhoods.

Preference

- You will visit <u>up to</u> 2 chapters in person.
- Preference is a much more serious and formal round. As a PNM, you are to be very respectful when entering a chapter's preference room.
- You will speak with your Rho Gamma after preference is finished, however will not submit your preferences with her.
- You will go to
 Clayton hall to sign the MRABA.

What items should be brought to recruitment?

Water, snacks, jacket, chargers

What happens if you encounter any technical problems during the virtual rounds?

You will be rescheduled to meet with the particular chapter at a different time

When will the schedules for each round be posted?

Your Rho Gamma will provide you with your schedule the first day of each round

How many bids can a PNM get?

You can only receive one bid

What is the next step after receiving a bid?

If you receive a bid, you will be going to that chapter's bid day right after receiving your bid. Your chapter will provide you with all the information you need from there!

Do all PNMs receive a bid?

If you put your best foot forward, put in the effort to get to know the chapters and maximize your options, then you will most likely receive a bid

Yes!










How much does it cost to go through the recruitment process?

There is a \$75 nonrefundable fee to sign up for recruitment. Each chapter has semesterly dues that members need to pay. Each chapter's dues are different, and the individual chapters will be discussing their dues during recruitment. Every chapter offers financial plans and scholarship options for those who need them, so do not let costs deter you from going through recruitment!

Can sophomores and juniors go through recruitment as well?

Yes! There are many sophomores and juniors who go through recruitment every year.





Throughout the rounds will it be more us PNMs asking the chapters questions to get to know them, or will they also be asking us questions?

Both! The chapter members will be asking you questions to get to know you, and it is also recommended to ask any questions that you have so that you can get to know the chapter to the best of your ability.
